Will Waters Sizzles with 11-under-par 61

Congratulations to Coharie CC Board member Will Waters, who on Sun., Aug. 3, recorded what is believed to be the lowest score ever shot on our golf course.

Playing in the so-called "Big Group," Waters made 12 birdies on his way to an 11-under-par 61.

"It was amazing," said playing partner Smokey Norris, who noted that the only green Will missed was the par-3 fourth.

Waters made his only bogey on No. 4 after chipping to about four feet and then lipping out his par putt.

Will's finish was particularly impressive as he birdied 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18.

Whether his round can be called a course record is a tough question to answer because he was not playing in an official competition

and he was playing from the regular tee markers.

Record or not, it is probably safe to describe his score as the lowest ever at Coharie.
