## Bridgestone Demo Day Will Be Different

It's called the Bridgestone Golf Ball Fitting Challenge and here's how it works.

Using the driver, golfers will hit a series of shots using their current ball of choice. A technician will either confirm that golfers are playing the right ball or recommend a Bridgestone/Precept ball that better suits the player's game.

According to the promotional literature, 70% of golfers who have taken the

Challenge have increased their driving distance by about 12 yards.

# Veteran Thore Ties for 1st in Pro-Am

David Thore was a junior standout in his youth, was an All-America golfer on some great Wake Forest University teams and won a number of Carolinas PGA major championships during his long career as a golf professional.

Now a retired PGA Life Member living in Wilmington, Thore got a share of the glory in the recent Coharie CC Pro-Amateur golf tournament. He shot a par-matching 72 to tie Ian Milne of Stryker

Golf Club at Fort Bragg for low pro honors. Each of the winning pros collected \$353.03 from the \$3796 purse.

Our own Dickie Walters was third with a 74, which earned him a \$250.54 payday.

In the team division, which used a best-ball net plus best-ball gross format, assistant pro Paul Dickens of River Landing in Wallace combined with members Jackie Parrish, Mike Gupton and Randy Wiggins to

drub the field.

Their team posted a 16-under-par 128 to win by eight strokes over the team captained by PGA Life Member Reid Schrone of Wilmington.

The pro-am participants were treated to beverages on the course during the round and a full meal at the conclusion of play.
