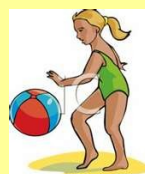

All the limbs from the trees are piled up in several areas on the course and will need to be carried to the landfill over the next few months. Daw's Tree Service will be out a couple of days a week for the next two months grinding stumps and cutting down limbs that have broken off trees but not fallen to the ground.

B & B Fence Company out of Clinton will be out in the next few days to repair the Tennis Court Fence. Net Connection from Birmingham, Alabama will be at Coharie the week of June 13<sup>th</sup> to replace the netting on the driving range

# Pool Rules

## 2011 Pool Rules for Coharie Country Club

1. Lifeguards are in charge of the pool area at all times. Do not engage in conversation or distract lifeguards on duty.
2. Parents are required to watch their children (under age 9) in all areas of the pool (diving board, slide, shallow end of pool, and bathrooms).
3. Children age 9 and older must pass a swimming test before being left alone at the pool.
4. Lifeguards will remove swimmers for threatening weather.
5. Members must sign-in all visitors.
6. Adults and lifeguards only are allowed in the pool during break.
7. Adult alcoholic beverages must be in styrofoam cups.
8. Place all trash in trash cans provided.
9. Only one person allowed on the diving board at a time.
10. Proper swimming attire is required. No cut off jeans, khakis, etc.
11. Anyone caught inside pool area, while closed, will be suspended for the summer.
12. Non-member babysitters must be with the member's children and must sign-in.
13. A cover up must be worn when entering the clubhouse.

### The "NO" Rules:

- No glass containers or bottles
- No food, drinks, or gum in the pool
- No skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles or golf carts inside fence
- No running or horse playing
- No hanging or standing on the division ropes in the pool
- No hanging from diving board, slide, or basketball goal
- No diving in the shallow end of the pool
- No dogs or other animals inside the fence
- No use of profanity, underage drinking, or illegal drugs
- No display of public affection
- No loitering in the parking lot
- No sneaking in visitors without "sign-up"

### What happens if we violate the rules:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense-verbal warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense-30 minute suspension
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense-1 day suspension
- 4<sup>th</sup> offense-pool review board (options: 1-2-3 week suspension or loss of pool privileges)

Members who choose to violate the rules will have their name, date and offense written in the pool journal. Offenses will accrue and punishment will follow!

**In Town Guests:** Yes, you can bring your in-town friends up to three (3) times this summer. Your account will be charged \$7.00 per day/per person.

**Out of Town Guest(s):** No charge

**Pool Parties:** To reserve your party, please contact Illona Egge.

Pool may be reserved Monday through Saturday from 6:00PM-10:30PM

- \$75 per hour for the first two (2) hours
- \$50 per hour for the last two (2) hours

### Coharie Pool Hours:

Monday through Saturday, 11 am until 7 pm  
Sunday, 1 pm until 8 pm

### Pool Breaks:

10 minutes every hour on the hour
