Interclub Champs!



Team Coharie

Early Friday morning, November 12, 2010, Coharie PGA Professional Dickie Walters lead a contingent of 16 golfers to Southern Pines to compete in the "Final Four" of the Interclub playoffs. Coharie Country Club was the only team from last years final four that qualified for this years finals.

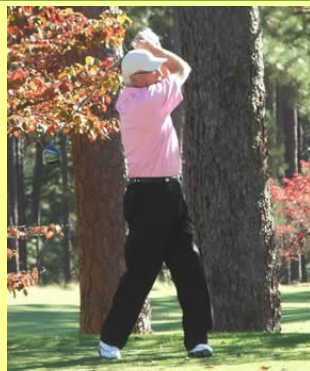
Coharie captured their 1st CGA Interclub Championship on Sunday, November 14th by the narrowest of margins (2 points) over the 2008 Champions from Rock Hill CC (Rock Hill, SC). This was the third time

in the history of the CGA Interclub that the final score was the closest it could be without a sudden-death playoff, and the second time that the final putt in the last group determined the outcome. The "Final-Four" format involves 16 players from each club competing in Four-Ball (best ball) and Individual Singles Matches with the most cumulative points determining the champion. Two points are awarded for a singles win and two points in each four-ball match.

Drawing on a gritty runner-up finish last year at Pine Needles, Coharie was determined to make another run at the championship and had to win three playoff matches (over Southern Wayne CC, Chapel Hill CC and Anderson Creek GC) in order to advance to the semi-finals on this 1921 Donald Ross gem. The week-end weather was a carbon copy of perfect conditions in 2009, as both semi-final matches on Saturday ended with the same score.

In their semi-final match on a chilly early Saturday morning, Coharie jumped out to an early, seemingly un-surmountable **24 – 6** lead through the first five of eight groups. But the Preserve closed the gap to 6 match points following consecutive 6 point wins. Needing only a halve in one of the three matches in the final pairing, Coharie's Brent Parrish posted a 4&3 win over Bob Christenson to pull out the **28 – 20** win to join Rock Hill in Sunday's showdown.

In the Championship match on Sunday, Coharie took the early lead again under a beautiful Carolina blue sky as Mike Gupton and Ronnie Williams won all three matches for an early 6-0 lead. J.P. Chamberlin won 7 holes on the front side to secure 2 points early in his individual match over Jeff Heath. Although teammate Kevin Tindal was closed out on the 15th hole, his (6 iron) ace on the 180 yard 11th hole beat Jeff Heath's birdie to help win the four-ball match. Coharie now led 22 – 20 and the last group was on the 18th fairway. With both individual matches closed out (Coharie's Will Waters winning 4&3 over Sam McCrorey and Rock Hill's Alex Finke 2&1 over Brent Parrish), the final results would be decided on the outcome of their four-ball match. The team match was all even, as Coharie need only a halve to secure the championship while Rock Hill needed to win the 18th hole to force sudden death. All four players hit the green with McCrorey the closest at 6

feet to the left and hole-high. When the other three players missed their birdie attempts, Parrish was conceded a tap in for par. As teammates and fans stood on the practice green above the 18th, they watched McCrorey's birdie putt slide by the front edge. As the putt rolled by the hole, the entire Coharie team knew they had "Eeked" out the victory.
