The early morning hours of Saturday, December 4, 2010, a one inch water pipe going from the water heater to the kitchen cracked inside the wall. Numerous gallons of water leaked inside the wall, as well as, on the floor ruining the carpet, paneling, and walls inside the closet that stores the water heater. Our insurance adjuster estimated damages were just over \$8,500.00. Plans are under way to replace the existing carpet, paneling, repaint the inside of the lounge, and re-stain the bar. Bids have been taken and a contractor has been hired to repair the damages. Construction will begin around the middle of January.
