Post Your Golf Scores To Play in Interclub

The Carolinas Golf Association has announced a new policy regarding player eligibility for the 2010 Interclub Matches.

In order to be eligible, a player must have posted a **minimum of 10 scores within the past 12 months**. So, when the weather gets more decent, it's important that we post our scores after each round.

Players also are required to have a low handicap index of **18.4 or less** in order to be eligible to participate.

The CGA has also expanded its "Final Four" format to include 16 players (plus 2 alternates) from each club.

The season-ending semifinals will be held Nov. 13 at Mid Pines Club in Southern Pines, NC while the championship match is set for Sunday, Nov. 14, also at Mid Pines.

The consolation match to determine third and fourth places has been eliminated.

Weather Taking Its Toll On Golf at Coharie

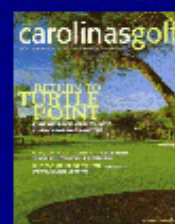

Outgoing president Waters expressed his appreciation to the membership for their support during his time in office and gave special thanks to the outgoing board members and to general manager Dickie Walters and his staff for their hard work and dedication to the club.

Mike Lanier went over the club's financial status with the attendees. In 2009, the club suffered a \$23,000 loss, which was considered acceptable in light of the nation's weak economy. A \$6,014

profit is projected in the 2010 budget.
