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Coharie CC Duo Wins N.C. Four-Ball Title

Congratulations to our very own Brent Parrish and Chris Eaves, who recently claimed victory in a Carolinas Golf Association major championship.

Brent and Chris shot 68-64-66—198 to win the North Carolina Four-Ball Championship at Keith Hills Country Club in Buies Creek. They finished one stroke ahead of brothers Mark Slawter of Wake Forest and Sutton Slawter of Winston-Salem. The Slawters turned the front-side with a slim one-stroke lead on the

field only to see it quickly vanish when Eaves birdied the 10th and Parrish birdied the 11th. Eaves and Parrish would hold the lead to the finish.

Chris is a sales rep for US Foodservice who lives in Burgaw, while Brent is a warehouse manager from Clinton. Their last round 6-under par 66 tied the second low round of the day. "Brent really kept our momentum going with a great 15-foot par save on 7," said a relieved Eaves. "Even though it was for par, that was a turning point for us."
