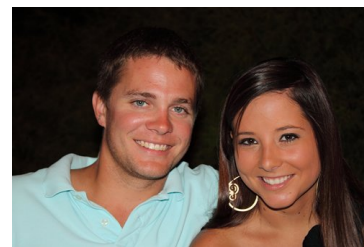
Each day prizes were awarded for the longest drive on hole 3 and closest to the pin on holes 4,6,10 and 15.
